

## Purpose

The Chapter Auxiliary is established to assist the Falcons Landing Chapter, MOAA, in executing its purpose and objectives, specifically, to actively support

- Those who are Serving;
- Those who have Served; and
- Those who have Survived

The Auxiliary is a separate, self-governed organization that shares the same purposes and objectives of the Chapter, it is established specifically to directly support the Chapter's programs and initiatives.

## Status

The Auxiliary is a nonprofit charitable organization per IRS 501(c)(3) whose only purpose is as specified above.

## Membership

Membership in the Auxiliary is comprised of the Auxiliary President, Chapter Surviving Spouses (defined by MOAA as widows and widowers of any deceased individuals who would, if living, be eligible for MOAA membership) and any other persons in the community not eligible for MOAA membership in their own right but who wish to assist in the work of the Auxiliary.

## Dues

There will be no membership dues assessed for members of the Auxiliary. Those members of the Auxiliary who are also members of National MOAA (i.e., Surviving Spouses) will be assessed dues as prescribed by MOAA.
